
Remote Programming Steps

Program Remote to Receiver

- Press and hold the blue 'Door Code' button on the garage door opener or 'SW1' or 'SW2' on the receiver board.
- 2. On the new remote, press the button you would like to use for 2 seconds.
- 3. Release the remote button and wait for 2 seconds.
- Press the same button again for 2 seconds.
- 5. Release the 'Door Code' or 'SW' button'.

Program Existing Remote to New Remote

- 1. Take any existing remote. Press the button which functions the garage door motor and release after activation.
- 2. On the existing remote, insert a small needle onto 'Coding Hole', press and hold firmly for 2 seconds.



- 3. Within 10 seconds, press and hold the button you would like to use on the new remote for 2 seconds.
- Release the remote button and wait for 2 seconds.
- **5.** Press the same button again for 2 seconds.

Deleting All Remotes from Receiver

- 1. Turn off the receiver (garage door motor.)
- 2. Press and hold the blue 'Door Code' button on the garage door opener or 'SW1' on the receiver board. Turn on the power again, while holding the button. A coding LED will light up.
